Mathematics: In the last weeks of Autumn 2, Year 6 completed their second assessment. This will be used during Spring 1 to focus on the needs of our children. In mathematics, we will be covering reasoning and arithmetic-based problems to develop our pupils learning and understanding. We encourage the use of Times Table Rock Stars at home to further develop your child's understanding.

English: In our English lessons, we will be writing a balanced argument which will discuss who was to blame for the sinking of the Titanic, which sank on route to New York. Alongside this, Year 6 will create a setting description based on the significant event of September 11th in New York.

Diversity texts: Our diversity texts this half term include 'Can you see me' by Libby Scott and 'Pig-Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman.

PE: This half term, PE will take place every Monday and Thursday. Our PE topics for this half term are netball and gymnastics.





Geography: Our Geography lessons this half term will focus on answering the question 'Why does the population change?'. Year 6 will develop their geographical understanding of not only the local area, but they will particularly focus on America (both North and South America) to contextualise their learning.

RE: In RE, Year 6 will be examining the Sikhism, discussing the concept of a 'soul' and the creation stories of different religions.

Text driver: Our text driver for this half term is 'the story of the Titanic', a nonfiction text by DK publishing.

Foreign Languages: For Year 6's foreign languages lessons, they will be focussing on 'monster description'. In this unit, they will develop their oracy in describing different body parts.

DT: In our DT lessons this half term, Year 6 will be focussing on 'seasonal food'. The class will examine different seasonal produce, identify how to correct preserve food, and conclude this
