Mathematics

In maths we use Maths Mastery to support our learning of numbers within 10, calendar and time, addition and subtraction and grouping and sharing.

Expressive Arts

The children will express their imagination in the airport role play, creating Chinese New Year decorations and designing their valentines' cards. We also have weekly music lessons based on transport.

Physical Development

Reception will have weekly PE lessons alongside outdoor play using various equipment. They will also be developing their fine motor skills in the tinkering and construction area with activities such as using chopsticks. We will be developing health and self-care by trying new foods and thinking about the effects of exercise. The children will have daily phonics sessions where we follow the Little Wandle scheme; they will learn new sounds to develop their reading. We will start with phase 3 sounds and recap the phase 2 sounds we learned. We use Drawing Club to ignite the children's imagination whilst developing the children's comprehension and writing skills.

Personal social and Emotional Development

We will be exploring countries from around the world and comparing them to where we live. We will be comparing animals, weather, buildings, clothing, cultures, and traditions. The role play area will be transformed into an airport, so the children can jet off to wherever they desire.

The children will be continuing to develop their listening, attention and speaking skills through play and exploration with other peers in the airport role play area.

Understanding the World

The children will learn about England, Spain, Kenya, Australia, Brazil and China. Comparing animals, weather, buildings, cultures, and traditions. They will also be learning about the seasonal changes which happen in winter and exploring changes in state (Ice).
