In mathematics, we will be covering reasoning and arithmetic-based problems to develop our pupils learning and understanding. English: In our English lessons, we will be writing a narrative based on the visual literacy story 'Alma'. Additionally, Year 6 will complete a non-chronological report in the style of a survival guide for Camp Green Lake.

PE: This half term, PE will take place every Monday and Thursday. Our PE topics for this half term are netball and tag rugby.
