

Mathematics: We will be using Ark Maths Mastery to help support our learning in the units; decimals, area and perimeter and money problems. We will develop our understanding of key mathematical vocabulary daily through "I say, we say, you say" strategies. The children will move through a range of Rehearse, Embed and Deepen questions.

Music: Year 4 will continue developing their ukulele chords and will continue to learn new songs that incorporate more skills than previously learnt.

PSHE: We will develop our awareness and understanding of how we develop and change around others through our Jigsaw Unit "Relationships."

PE: This half term we will be completing tennis and cricket during our P.E lessons. Learning key skills and the rules of the game.

RE: We will learn about our focus religion "Judaism" and how they show commitment to God.

English: By the end of Summer 1, the children will have written a "persuasive letter" and a "narrative." Children will also develop their vocabulary, retrieval, and inference skills in reading lessons.

Rainforests 2024-2025



We will be developing knowledge and understanding of geography through studying "Rainforests." By looking at maps on different scales, how the weather and climate impact on rainforests around the world. They will study how the rainforests are changing and the effects of deforestation.
