Mathematics: We will be using Ark Maths Mastery to help support our learning in the units; shape, position and direction and reasoning patterns. We will develop our understanding of key mathematical vocabulary daily through "I say, we say, you say" strategies. The children will move through a range of Rehearse, Embed and Deepen questions.

Music: Year 4 will continue developing their ukulele chords and will continue to learn new songs that incorporate more skills than previously learnt.

PSHE: We will develop our awareness and understanding of how we develop and change around others through our Jigsaw Unit "Changing Me."

PE: This half term we will be completing tennis and athletics on rotation during our P.E lessons. Learning key skills and the rules of the game. The children will take part in forest school sessions to develop gross and fine motor skills. Summer 2 2025 - Year 4 are learning about:



Rivers
