

Mathematics - We will use 'Maths Mastery' resources to help support our learning of Number Sense, Place Value and Graphs. We will develop our understanding of key mathematical vocabulary through daily "I Say, We Say, You Say". The children will move through a range of rehearse, embed and deepen questions to ensure they cement their understanding of the concepts.

English - To begin with, Year 3 will be exploring prehistory through poetry. The children will perform a poem. We will then produce a narrative and a persuasive advertisement. The children will also be developing their knowledge of new vocabulary along with their skills of retrieval and inference.

The Stone Age
to Iron Age



History: We will be developing knowledge and understanding of pre-history through our study of the "Stone Age to the Iron Age". Placing and ordering key events on a timeline, exploring and comparing the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods, investigating life in the Bronze Age, exploring how life changed in Iron Age Britain and comparing how technology changed throughout this period.

Foreign Languages - We will focus on Spanish and the unit, 'All About Me'. This unit will mainly centre around introducing oneself and greeting one another in Spanish. Children will listen and engage in conversations while developing accuracy and pronunciation through repetition of key words and phrases.

Science - This half term will have a biology focus, studying animals: movement and nutrition. We will explore the role of the skeleton and muscles, learn how the body uses energy and what constitutes a balanced diet.

Computing - This term, we will be introduced to the concept of networks, learning how devices communicate. We will identify components and learn how information is shared. We will also explore how websites work.

PE - We will develop our skills and accuracy through weekly sessions of "Football". We will also have fortnightly sessions of Forest School.

RE - We will learn about our focus religion "Sikhism" and explore the ways in which joining the Khalsa can make a Sikh a better person.

Music - We will focus on ballads by identifying their key features and culminate our learning with writing and performing our own musical verse.

PSHE - We will develop our awareness and understanding for making positive choices and how our own actions can have an impact on other people's feelings as part of our Jigsaw unit 'Being in my world'.

Design and Technology - We will be making cushions. We will practise basic running stitch to create a join. We will then use cross stitch and applique to decorate our designs.
