



English - This half term we will be learning about **Lost and Found** and **Beegu**. We will be using adjectives, conjunctions and the past tense to write our own narratives.

Maths - We will use 'Ark Maths Mastery' resources to help support our learning of fractions and numbers to 100. We will focus on half and quarter of shapes, objects, and quantities in fractions. We will then focus on numbers to 100, consider the value of each digit and number bonds to 100. We will develop our understanding of key mathematical vocabulary through daily "I say, you say, you say, we say." The children will move through a range of fluency questions.

Art - Our focus artist will be Louise Bourgeois and we will learn to sculpt structures using paper by bending, folding and rolling it into different shapes.

Phonics

This half term, we will continue to learn phase 5 sounds and practice reading them in words and begin to learn how to select the correct alternate grapheme pronunciation for different words.

Geography Summer 1 2025-2026

What is it like to live in Shanghai?

We will be developing knowledge and understanding of geography by learning about the different continents. We will be thinking about the human and physical features of Shanghai and comparing them with our local area, considering the similarities and differences.

Computing - We will work create algorithms by learning to use Bee Bots and program a set of instructions for them to follow.

PSHE - This term we will be learning about economic wellbeing. We will be learning about what money is and how we can keep it safe. We will consider the difference between saving and spending money and finally think about different jobs adults can have.

R.E - We will learn about our focus religion, "Judaism", and explore the importance of the Shabbat to Jewish children.

Music - We will be developing our music skills using the Kapow scheme of work. The terms focus pitch and is explored through the theme of Superheroes.

Homework

In Year 1, homework will be given out on a Friday and should be returned to Miss Vincent by the following Friday.

Children will be given Spelling homework linked to their phonics learning in the week and will be tested the following Friday. They will also be given a reading book to read at home with their adult three times a week. Year 1 will also be given a Numbots login to support and develop their fluency in maths.
