



Mathematics: This half term, Year 2 will be enhancing their knowledge of number. They will then apply this knowledge to their maths lessons where they will be looking at graphs time, multiplication and division and fractions. Year 2 will be focusing on their 2s, 5s and 10s times tables using our pictorial,

English: In English this half term, we will be using the key text driver 'Grandads Camper' and 'Tadpole's Promise'. Year 2 will be writing an extended explanation and a sequel narrative.

Diversity Texts: Our diversity texts are: The Name Jar by Yangsook Choi, Gregory Cool by Caroline Binch, Coming to England by Floella Benjamin, Sulwe by Lupita Nyong'o, Martin Luther King Jr. (Little People, BIG DREAMS) J is for Jamaica by Benjamin

Science: In science this half term, Year 2 will be exploring the uses of everyday materials. Year 2 will be comparing the suitability of materials by carrying out tests and recording data.

Spring 1 2026 – Class 2B are learning about:

Living in hot or cold places.

Geography: In geography this half term, Year 2 will be looking at whether they would like to live in a hot or cold place. They will name and locate the seven continents, the North and the South Poles and the Equator on a world map. Year 2 will describe some similarities and differences between the UK and Kenya and investigate whether they would like to live in a hot or cold place. They will then locate some countries with hot or cold climates on a world map.

Music: Year 2 will be focusing on singing with a focus on traditional folk songs and creating sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.

Art: This half term, Year 2 will be looking at the work of Romare Bearden, mixing colours and exploring life in colour.

RE: In RE this half term, Year 2 will be focusing on Judaism, Passover and Jewish traditions. This will support us to reflect on and represent things that are important to us and why.

PE: Year 2 will be looking at 2 Gymnastics this half term. They will explore and develop basic gymnastic actions on the floor and using apparatus. Year 2 will develop gymnastic skills of jumping, rolling, balancing and travelling individually to create short sequences.

Computing: In Computing, we are looking at word processing and looking at using shortcuts.
