

Mathematics: This half term, Year 2 will be enhancing their knowledge of numbers through different working out methods such as the ones and tens frame. They will then apply this knowledge to their maths lessons. They will be looking at, fractions, money and addition and subtraction. Year 2 will be looking at missing number problems in their MOT lessons and will also focus on embedding their knowledge of their 2s, 5s and 10 times tables.

Computing: In computing year 2 will be developing their confidence with the keyboard and the basics of touch typing. Also, we will be creating and labelling images and then collecting and inputting data into a spreadsheet. Furthermore, they will be learning how computers are used in the wider world.

Music: Year 2 will be learning to explain why the music has a certain effect on them, which could be related to the music or a personal experience. We will be identifying some common instruments when listening to music and relating it to sounds in music to real-world experiences (e.g. 'It sounds like squelching mud').

PE: Year 2 will be looking at Physical: throw, catch, hit, track, balance, run. Thinking: select and apply, reflection, decision making, comprehension. Social: co-operation, respect, support others. Emotional: perseverance, honesty. We will learn to develop our racket skills and use them to return a ball.

Science: In science this half term, Year 2 will be identifying different stages of the human life cycle and the stages of animal life cycles and carrying out tests to record growth.

Spring 2 Class 2B

English: In English this half term, we will be using the key text 'Dear Earth and 'Grandads Camper' we will be writing both fiction and non-fiction this half term, writing a narrative and a leaflet as well as writing and performing our own poem!

In history this half term, Year 2 will be looking at 'historically significant' people are those who changed many people's lives and to know that historians use evidence from sources to find out more about the past. We will be looking at the impact of a historical event on society. Furthermore year 2 will be looking at how the past monarchs had absolute power and to be aware of the achievements of significant individuals.

RE: In RE this half term, Year 2 will be focussing on Christianity and the Easter story. Year 2 will be looking at the significance of Easter and will be looking at the key events of the story.

PSHE: This half term, Year 2 will be looking at citizenship. To recognise that different rules apply in different situations and explain what makes a good school environment. Also to recognise similarities and difference between people in the local community.

Art: This half term, Year 2 will be exploring the work of Ranti Bam, describing their work through visual information. They will use practical skills and apply artistic techniques to shape and decorate clay and design and make a clay til with house features.
