

Mathematics: In the last week of Spring 1, Year 6 completed their second assessment. This will be used during Spring 2 to focus on the needs of our children. In mathematics, we will be covering reasoning and arithmetic-based problems to develop our pupils learning and understanding. We encourage the use of Times Table Rock Stars at home to further develop your child's understanding.

English: In our English lessons, we will be writing a narrative based on the visual literacy story 'Alma'. Additionally, Year 6 will complete a non-chronological report in the style of a survival guide for Camp Green Lake.

Science: This half term, we will continue our science unit is 'Living things: Evolution and inheritance'. During their lessons, Year 6 will be exploring variation and inheritance in different living things and understanding of how observations and fossils have led to the theory of evolution.
