

Maths

This half term we will secure our knowledge of fractions, percentages and decimals as well as huge focus on using our mathematical knowledge to solve reasoning problems.

English

We will start the half term using 'The day the crayons quit' by Drew Daywalt to write a letter as a disgruntled object. We will then write an extended narrative.

PE: Athletics

In this unit, pupils are set challenges for distance and time that involve using different styles and combinations of running, jumping and throwing.

Music: Baroque Music

Through listening, performing and composing activities, the children will develop a strong understanding of key Baroque features and build confidence reading staff notation.

History: The Sikh Empire.

In this unit, students will explore how leaders, beliefs, places and events shaped the Sikh Empire. They will analyse evidence, understand different viewpoints and explain why certain events or individuals are significant.

Computing: Programming

Students will begin learning the foundations of text-based programming through Python. They build on their knowledge of block-based coding and develop the skills needed to write, understand and debug simple programs.

In Reading, we will develop our comprehension skills using a range of text types. We will also read and discuss 'A Christmas Carol.' By Charles Dickens.
