

English - In Writing, the pupils will write a non-chronological report while studying the text 'Weslandia'. The class will also study 'The story of Tutankhamun' and will write a biography.

Text Drivers/Supporting Texts - In Reading the pupils will read 'The fossil hunter' and 'Humans'.

Science - We will focus on classification and changing habitats as part of our biology work. This half term, the children will be investigating the grouping of living things, seasonal changes in habitats and human impact on habitats.

Art - This unit focuses on teaching children the use painting and mixed media. The children will learn about tints and shades, three dimensions and painting techniques to work on still life.

Music - This term, we will continue our music lessons with Miss Tomlinson.

Maths - We will continue to use 'Maths Mastery' in order to develop children's key understanding of mathematical vocabulary while moving the children through a range of rehearse, embed and deepen questions. This term's focus will be measure, money problems, shape and symmetry, and position and direction.

Year 4 - Summer 1 2026 - Geography

Where does our food come from?

This half term, the class will explore the Ancient Maya civilisation by placing its key periods in chronological order and comparing them with what was happening in Britain at the same time. Pupils will learn how the Maya settled in the rainforest, the challenges this environment posed, and how they adapted to overcome them. They will also study Maya beliefs.

Computing - Creating Media The children will be developing their digital skills by learning about computational thinking.

P.E - The children will build on their skills of coordination and accuracy through weekly sessions on 'Athletics' and 'Cricket'.

Foreign Languages - This unit focuses on Spanish Celebrations. Children will continue to develop their understanding of spoken Spanish whilst using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structure.

PSHE - The children will be learning all about economic wellbeing. This unit will focus on value of money, how to look after and keep track of money. Pupils will also learn about career changes, what influences people towards a career, and workplace stereotypes.

R.E - We will learn about our focus religion "Sikhism". Pupils will develop their understanding of the beliefs and values of Sikhism.
